Applications for the Strathbogie Shire Community Grants Program open from 9am Monday 18th March until 4pm Friday 26th April 2019 for projects commencing after 1st July 2019.

Grant categories for the 2019 program include:

Grant Category	Maximum grant amount
Active and Healthy Communities	\$5000
Arts & Culture	\$5000
Environment and Sustainability	\$5000
Facilities and Infrastructure	\$5000
Small Projects	\$1000

Event grants have been removed from the Community Grants Program this year, as Council would like event organisers to alternatively apply for sponsorship, which is now available throughout the entire year.

Council is running a number of information sessions to discuss changes to the grant guidelines, the SmartyGrants application process and to answer any questions groups may have about the Community Grants Program.
