Strathbogie Shire Council is calling on businesses to participate in its fifth edition of the Nagambie Lakes and Strathbogie Ranges Official Visitors Guide (OVG) 2019-2021.

For the very first time, businesses will also have the opportunity to be included in a tourism app that will assist visitors with locating restaurants, attractions and accommodation.

Council is currently in initial discussions about the development of the app, alongside a brand new website, in a bid to improve online engagement with residents and grow a stronger online presence to showcase the region.

This is currently in the early stage of development, but will be available to businesses that purchase advertising in the Official Visitors Guide at no extra cost.

Strathbogie Shire Mayor Amanda McClaren said the OVG and tourism app provide a great promotional opportunity for local businesses.

“There were 60,000 copies of the last Official Visitors Guide printed in 2015 and these have gone on the shelves of Visitors Information Centres across Victoria, as well as being distributed at conferences, trade shows and added to showbags for visiting groups,” Cr McClaren explained.

“The Official Visitors Guide is specifically designed to create demand for our tourism products and services.”

“We also know that 40 per cent of people are using a mobile device to tour the region, so the tourism app will be an exciting addition to our marketing efforts,” Cr McClaren said.

The OVG will be a professionally designed, A5 sized brochure and will be formatted to be easily recognisable to visitors.

It is anticipated that 40,000 copies of the OVG will initially be printed and widely distributed across the network of accredited Visitor Information Centres, local tourism businesses and uploaded to the Strathbogie Shire website.
