THE PROBLEM

Strathbogie Shire is located in the Hume Region, approximately 90 minutes from Melbourne. It is comprised of the diverse townships of Avenel, Euroa, Nagambie, Strathbogie and Violet Town. The shire covers over 3,300 square kilometres and has a population of over 10,000 people.

Strathbogie Shire was recognised as the second most popular retirement destination in in 2017, with approximately 19 percent of the population above the age of 70 and those over the age of 60 the fastest growing population. The region has limited aged and acute healthcare services to meet the growing demands of an increasingly ageing population.

THE SOLUTION

Council is seeking support for the development of more permanent public hospital beds in the health facilities across the Strathbogie Shire and a greater amount of aged care facilities and home care options.
