- ✓ Energy efficiency – where your community group likely uses its energy, behaviour changes to reduce energy, how to select the best tariff based on your energy use profile
- ✓ Case studies and a review of your community groups' energy bills

The workshop will take place on Thursday, 22 November, from 6- 8.30pm at Strathbogie Shire Council in the Conference Room, via the Bury Street entrance.

Strathbogie Shire Mayor Amanda McClaren said the workshop provides a great opportunity for local community groups to get the advice they need to make informed decisions about their energy.

"This is a unique opportunity for groups to lower their outgoing costs by gaining a deeper understanding of how the energy market works with a plain-speaking expert," Cr McClaren explained.
