- **Green Waste** may be deposited at the appropriate transfer stations for the standard tipping fee. This material is mulched on site and made available free of charge for residents. Residents that wish to take free green waste must self-load the material and it is taken at own risk. The mulch quality varies from time to time and is not guaranteed by Council.
- **Asbestos** - None of Councils facilities accept asbestos. Contact EPA Victoria on 1300 372 842 or <https://www.epa.vic.gov.au/your-environment/waste/asbestos> for disposal locations
- **Chemical or Liquid Waste** – Are not accepted at any of Council's Facilities.
- **Commercial Quantities** – All loads and materials will be inspected by our Transfer Station Operators. All Operators have the right of refusal for non-compliant materials, or materials that may be considered a commercial quantity.
- We do not accept **Bricks, Concrete, Clean Fill** or **Tiles** at any of our sites.
- **Tyres** – maximum of six (6) tyres will be accepted per disposal.
